- Open Source
- Hosted on-premises @ git.etsu.edu
 - Only accessible on-campus
 - SSH or HTTPS
- Security Model
 - Users, Roles, Privs








GitLab Commit View






ETSU Dev Workflow


Branching Strategy for a Large Team/Project










Admin Pages – Deployment Walkthrough

- Deploy via ESM to "dummy" host
- Update war files
 - https://itswiki.etsu.edu/index.php/IS:AdminPagesWarConfig
 - https://git.etsu.edu/banner9/BannerAdmin/commit/d2b5e3be984dc09b60a070181bd6fabcb5daf7b2
- Update repo w/war or new configuration settings:
 - https://git.etsu.edu/ecs/AdminPages/tree/master/tsth
- GitlabCl executes deploy_to_s3.py
 - https://git.etsu.edu/ecs/AdminPages/blob/master/.gitlab-ci.yml
- Deploy to s3.py builds tarballs and pushes them to s3

- Ecs task

IaC


- Declares intent and interactions of resources

- Reduces go-live errors
- Manages "drift" of configurations




